Cotati, California (September 22, 2014) — The Cotati Oktoberfest returns to La Plaza Park for an eighth consecutive year with the quaffing of beer in steins, the um-pah-pah of old-time polkas, whiffs of grilled Bratwurst, and the always unpredictable Wiener Dog Races. The event takes place 12–6 p.m., Saturday, Oct. 11 in downtown Cotati and features a variety of entertainment, food and beverages under a large tent. Admission is free, costumes are encouraged and all ages are welcome.

Microbrews by Lagunitas Brewing Company, traditional Oktoberfest food and snacks, and collectible glass steins will be available for purchase. A Grilled German Bratwurst Dinner with one beverage (beer, wine or root beer) is \$15 while a single serving of beer or wine is \$5.

<u>The Showcase Band</u> from Sonoma Valley will perform traditional Oktoberfest music for polka dancing and listening.
