**Three Nights of Festive Fun
Cotati's Annual Holiday Celebration**

Cotati, California (October 21, 2014) — Three Nights of Festive Fun returns to Cotati on December 4, 5 and 6, bringing the traditional Yuletide spirit to “kids from one to ninety-two.” Thursday’s Holiday Cheer Pub Crawl is for adults only, but participation in the Holiday Tree Lighting and Candlelight Concert is absolutely free and kid friendly. The Cotati Chamber of Commerce and the City of Cotati produce the annual event located in-and-around the center of town.

Holiday Cheer Pub Crawl

The festivities begin Thursday at 5:30 p.m. with the Holiday Cheer Pub Crawl. Adult residents gather at the 8 Ball Tavern (8 Charles St) for a toast with friends and family while responsibly imbibing in alcoholic and non-alcoholic holiday cheer and sampling complimentary appetizers.

The group moves to Spancky’s Bar (8201 Old Redwood Hwy) at 6:15 p.m. for the second installment of holiday drink specials and finger foods, followed by a 7:00 p.m. stop at the Cotati Yacht Club (8099 La Plaza) and a 7:45 p.m. visit to Friar Tuck’s Pub (8201 Old Redwood Hwy) for a final sampling of food and beverages. Participants may join the ensemble at any time.



Holiday Tree Lighting

Friday’s Holiday Tree Lighting is the main event as hundreds of families gather to sing Christmas carols and enjoy cookies, cider, hot cocoa and a visit from Santa Claus in La Plaza Park from 6:00 – 8:00 p.m. “Jack Frost” may be “nipping on your nose,” so warm clothing is highly recommended for “tiny tots with their eyes all aglow” while watching the official lighting of the town tree.

Candlelight Concert

All ages are also welcome during Saturday’s Candlelight Concert from 7:00 – 9:00 p.m. at the Church of the Oaks (160 West Sierra Ave at Page St). Enjoy joyous singing and holiday music under the glow of warm candlelight in a nondenominational church known for its community service. Refreshments will be served as one and all have themselves a “merry little Christmas.”
